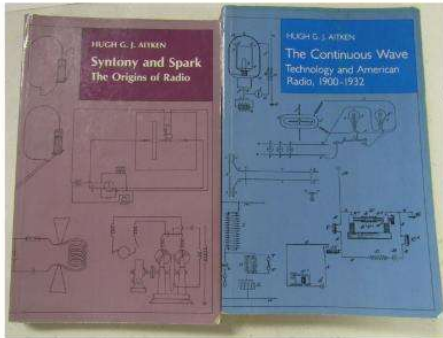
The Door Prize this month was a RCA VTVM
